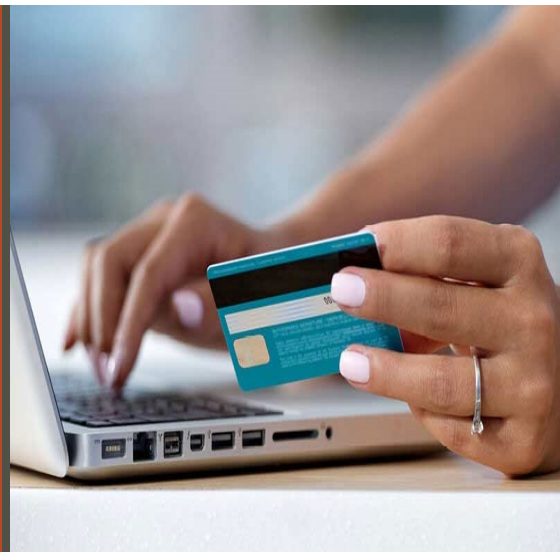


COLD WEATHER IS HERE!!!
