RE: Support for Styrofoam ban based on harm to marine life and treaty fish habitat.

The facts support banning Styrofoam, from the perspective of protecting fish habitat and treaty fishing rights. This is easily demonstrated through online research.

Styrofoam is made from polystyrene, a petroleum-based plastic. The central ingredient is styrene. It is linked to an array of harmful human health effects including reproductive deficiencies, genetic damage, and cancer. Whether these harms are manifested at historically typical levels of consumer exposure is controversial, but the actual environmental effects that result from the manufacture and use of Styrofoam are not seriously disputed. The continued routine use of Styrofoam when environmentally sound alternatives exist is therefore profoundly irrational.

Manufacturing Styrofoam causes air pollution. Online research shows that the National Bureau of Standards Center for Fire Research lists 57 chemical by-products that are released during the manufacture of Styrofoam, and none of them are good for human beings or wildlife. Additionally, it is manufactured by using HFCs, or hydrofluorocarbons, which have dangerous impacts on the ozone layer and global heating.

Online sources report that Americans throw away 25 billion Styrofoam cups every year. Presumably the figure is based on wholesale quantities sold, but even if discounted a thousand-fold, this is an unsustainable use both in terms of fossil fuels and harm to marine life. Styrofoam is not biodegradable. Over time it breaks into tiny pieces that are believed to last forever. It floats in water. Massive quantities already have accumulated along coasts and waterways around the world. **It is now considered the main component of marine debris.** Animals often mistake Styrofoam as food and eat it. This causes harm or death due to starvation, choking or chemical buildup in the digestive system.

There are environmentally sound alternatives to Styrofoam that are manufactured from renewable resources containing biodegradable materials that are easily recycled.

The Tribal Council has repeatedly recognized that the Tribe has a strong legal interest in protecting its treaty fisheries resources and fish habitat. It is beyond dispute that the manufacture and use of Styrofoam cause air pollution, global heating, water pollution, and harm to marine life, adding unnecessary burdens to the Tribe's programs for treaty fisheries protection.

Hi Jennifer,

What is the intention of the price list? Is it just to steer people in the direction of purchasing products that the sustainability group finds acceptable?

I also don't know if I would include in the memo that Chuckals said this that or the other. We really don't buy a ton of products from Chuckals that would fall into this category.

Most Styrofoam based products would be purchased through food supply vendors. Although Jon was able to confirm that we haven't bought any Styrofoam since 2020 this isn't really a good example to use since they aren't the only vendor that we use and these types of products just aren't typically purchased from them anyway.

Although Jon's statement is true, it's not a good example and on a broader spectrum just isn't true for overall on what the Tribe buys.

I would recommend restructuring the memo to Council to just state that facts about why Styrofoam and other plastic/single use products are bad and why we want to ban them. I also don't know that the price list is necessary. There are so many different products available now days that providing a list specific to Chuckals isn't really beneficial.
