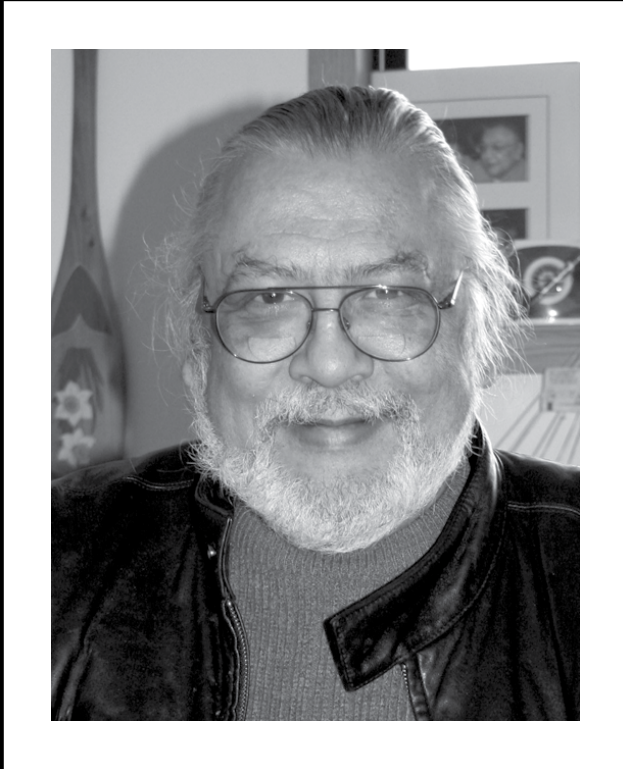


# LAWRENCE WILLIAM LAPOINTE
