- **Valuing our Elders** – I will listen to our elder's advice. I will push for more supportive, therapeutic, and alternative medical services in the new elder's facility.

- **Public Safety & Environment** – My top priority are our children and families. We must work together to make our communities safer and more livable. Cleaning up the reservation is vital to the health and welfare of our families.

- **Treaty Rights** – I will tackle taxation problems & work to remove the barriers for small businesses in our tribe. I will fight to preserve treaty rights and our natural resources!

- **Healthcare** – DSHS application process at the clinic for tribal members should be easier. Allocation of more resources to prevention & wellness services is critical if we are to slow diagnoses of chronic diseases such as diabetes and heart disease.

- **Fiscal Responsibility** – I will critically review all tribal programs & will not support ineffective or mismanaged programs any longer. Accountability for all tribal programs is long over due.

**MY FAMILY:** I come from a family committed to serving the tribe. My great-grandparents are the late Silas and Hattie Cross; Silas was a signer of our 1912 rolls and Hattie participated in the Boldt decision that won area tribes 50% of the available natural resources. My grandparents are the late Benjamin and Lucille Reed who operated a successful tribal business for many years. I have many aunts and uncles who have served on Tribal Council. My mother, Sharron Nelson, is a traditional dancer and master basket weaver. She was also the recorder for our land claims settlement and she once fished with my uncles who fought for our fishing rights.

I am **Dr. Danelle Reed-Inderbitzin** and I am seeking your support for tribal council this year. When elected I will give **110%** effort, enthusiasm, accountability, and honesty in my work.
